#### BEFORE THE MEETING

- Request a draft of the IEP, updated progress report, raw data, and any documents that will be discussed be sent home prior to the meeting.
- Write your parent input statement and send to casemanager prior to the meeting.
- Review the meeting notice for team participants...if someone is missing, reach out to the casemanager.

#### **DURING THE MEETING**

- Confirm required members will be present for the duration of the meeting
- Ask to review the agenda for the meeting.
- ✓ Take notes and ask questions.
- Confirm next steps and ask for a timeline for completion.

#### AFTER THE MEETING

- Review the meeting notes and if you have questions, contact the casemanager, ASAP.
- Keep track of dues dates on a calendar.
- Complete any next steps and follow-up with the casemanager.
- Carefully review all paperwork that comes after the meeting and if you have questions, ask!!
